**RULES:** Current NRA Rules will govern.

**REGISTRATION LIMITED:** Entries will be limited to the first 30 competitors to register. Please email your intent to participate to the Match Director as listed above with the corresponding date to facilitate advance squadding and to ensure an entry spot by emailing the Match Director listed above

by the the preceding Thursday. Include what category you will be firing in. (High Power Rifle (Sling), NRA Tactical (AR), FTR, or F-Open).

**EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR:** The use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is mandatory (Rule 3.21). They are available for \$1.00. from the match director during registration

**RIFLES ALLOWED FOR THIS EVENT:**

NRA any rifle with any sights,

NRA Tactical (AR),

F Class Target Rifles,

F Class Open.

All rifles **without a muzzle brake**, Silencers allowed when firing for practice only. and scores will not be eligible for placing in the match and will not be submitted to the NRA..

Tactical is AR based, 223 through-308, 14 lbs max,12X max scope, 20 inch barrel max, rear bag with no ears. Foldable Bipod directly on the ground. (Think of this as prone Service Rifle with a bipod and scope)(see 2016 NRA Rules)

An F-Class Target rifle is 223 or 308, no greater than 18.18 pounds, fired with attached bipod and rear bag.

An F-Class Open rifle can weigh up to 22 lbs, be any caliber .less than 33 cal, and may be fired from a mechanical front rest, with a rear bag rest. Please see the NRA rulebook for limits on supports.

**AWARDS:** Certificates awarded to top 3 places, within each Rifle Category.

**TARGETS:** 600 yards - MR1 or MR1FC for "F" Class Shooters

**Note,** The match may be fired at 300 yards based on Match Directors discretion.

**TARGET PULLERS:** No target pullers will be provided. Shooters will pull targets

**SIGHTING SHOTS:** 2 sighting shots will be allowed for each competitor for each stage of fire.

**COURSE OF FIRE;** 60 Shot Match (20 shots fired 3 times)

Stage 1: Slow Fire Prone: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record fired in 22 Minutes single shot

Stage 2: Slow Fire Prone: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record fired in 22 Minutes single shot

Stage 3: Slow Fire Prone: 2 sighting shots and 20 shots for record fired in 22 Minutes single shot

**FACILITIES:** The range has no protection from the weather. Please be prepared. There is no water available at the range. Please bring plenty to drink. Please bring a lunch. While there is no break for eating, during your time in the pits, there is time to eat. There are porta potties at the range.
